DISCUSS AND CONSIDER HEARING PROCEDURES

Legal Counsel James Underwood explained the Code sections by which the Board of Building Appeals (BBA) was designed and the rules for conduct of investigations and hearing appeals. All meetings must be performed in compliance with the Brown Act. The members of the Board of Building Appeals have been appointed and are members of various categories, knowledgeable in the construction trade.
