

**NOTICE OF INTENT (NOI) TO HARVEST TIMBER**

A Timber Harvesting Plan (THP) or Amendment has been submitted to the California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CAL FIRE). CAL FIRE Forest Practice will be reviewing the proposed timber operation for compliance with State law and rules of the California Board of Forestry and Fire Protection. The following briefly describes the proposed timber operation and where and how to get more information. Prior to submission of the THP or Amendment, this Notice, including a map as described in 14 CCR § 1032.7(d)(8) shall be posted at a conspicuous location on the public road nearest the Plan, be on colored paper or identified with colored flagging per 14 CCR § 1032.7(d)(10)(h) and adhere to any special county rules.

The estimated earliest possible date CAL FIRE may approve this THP or Amendment is: Oct 8, 2024

*(This estimated date is 15 calendar days from receipt of the THP or Amendment by CAL FIRE, except in counties for which special rules have been adopted where the earliest date is 45 calendar days after receipt.)*

**NOTE: The estimated earliest approval date is probably not the actual approval date.** Often, there is more time available for public comment submittals. Please check with CAL FIRE Forest Practice to determine the actual date that the public comment period closes.

Anyone may review or purchase a copy of the THP or Amendment from the CAL FIRE Review Team office shown below. The copying cost is **37 cents** for each page, \$2.50 minimum per request.

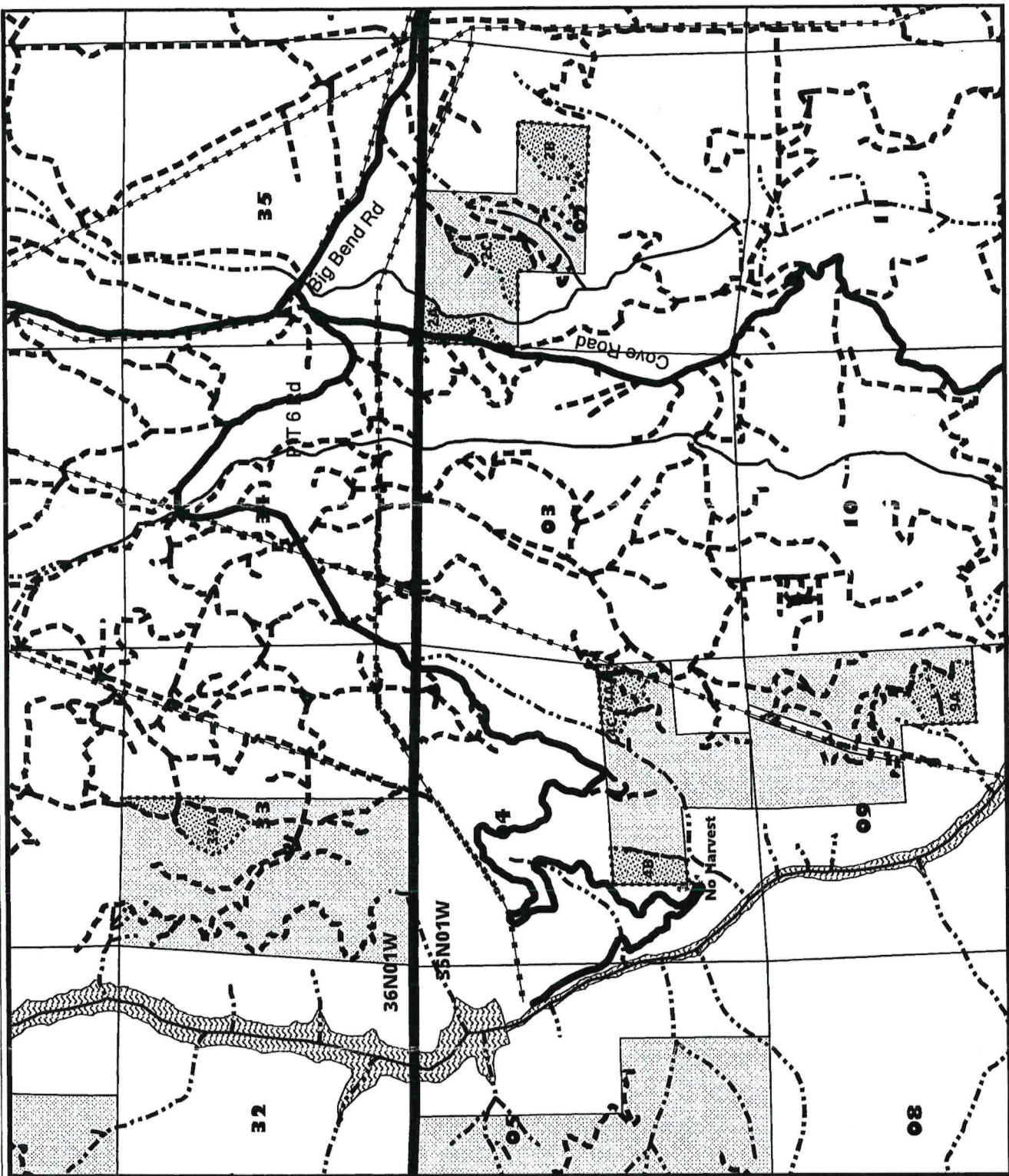
