PAROLEE POPULATION*: 362



Shasta County Probation Compliance Officer


The Probation Compliance Officer works with other probation officers and officers within the local law enforcement community to maintain consistent and regular personal contact with offenders on supervision and Supervised Own Recognizance (SOR). The goal is to enforce accountability by focusing on those offenders who disregard their supervision and treatment requirements, but conversely to reinforce participation in treatment and positive behavior for those under the department's supervision.

The Compliance Officer is in the field daily contacting offenders to include home visits, address verifications, searches, and arrests. Home visits are necessary to ensure the person is living at the address they provide to their probation officers, as well as addressing any issues the person may be having. For those who are not in compliance with supervision, regular contacts take place to improve said compliance and to hold them accountable. The Compliance Officer assists with global positioning system (GPS) issues for those wearing probation-supervised monitors in the community. Residence verifications are also conducted for the court on incoming cases to verify the individual has a valid residence within the county.


The Compliance Officer is a valuable member of the Shasta County Probation Department and is the primary contact for all joint operations with local law enforcement agencies. The Compliance Officer attends patrol shift briefings with local justice partners and organizes targets and participates in monthly operations with the Shasta County Sheriff's Department. This officer also serves as the lead high-risk contact officer for Probation Department Field Staff.

Shasta County Probation Compliance Statistics







Compliance by Supervision 2022/23
